#### Directions to assembly

Assembly 200-300m depending which pedestrian exit is used.

Cross Heaton Lane to George Hotel then walk up West side of main road to Viaduct Park and Assembly

If you end up in the Redrock Car park

## **Directions to Assembly**

From the pedestrian exit cross over Port street and round the corner past Joseph James and cross the main road to the George Hotel, turn left and Viaduct Park is 200m on the right.

Please don't cut across Mersey Square.

## Directions to Assembly (400m)

Walk down Station road to Macdonald traffic lights then turn left and Viaduct park assembly is 200m. Please do not use the signed path to Viaduct Park halfway down Station Road.

Bus any route to Stockport Bus station then take lift to Viaduct Park


Terrain

Complex Town centre with many steep alleyways and irregular street pattern, 1970's estate plus area to the West including small park and many streets and alleyways

The Stockport competition area is not Flat.

Courses 1, 2, 3. 1:4000 Urban map Double sided Courses 4, 5. 1:3000 Urban map Double sided Courses 6, 7, 8. 1:3000 Urban map Single sided



Multiple-level mapping in the Precinct

1 - the top of this building is actually a car park, which is what you will see when you're level with it. Don't be confused by it not looking like a building! 2 - the purple stripe OOB is the vehicle route into the top level of the car park

A, B, C - the brown striping is a balcony overlooking the ground level of the precinct. There are three access staircases, A, B, C, which are narrow and twisty. A and B carry on up to other things - make sure you exit the stairs at the first opportunity!



Multiple-level mapping at Viaduct Park

On the upper level, L is the last control for all courses, F is the Finish and D is Download.

On the riverside (ground) level, P is the penultimate control for courses 4-8.

Between these two levels, S is a spiral ramp which does a full circle underneath what the map shows.

Courses Standard UK urban league classes

All courses have a timed out road crossing at some pedestrian lights (1 minute 30secs)

Please follow marshals instructions.

Safety

If wet cobbled streets will be slippery.

The route to the road crossing is downhill on cobbles take care especially if wet.

(i.e. Type 5 Card No 1-499,999 and Type 8 Card Nos 2,000,001-2,999,999)  $\,$ 

Starts: There is one start for all courses

Start times 10:30 to 12:30

(Allocated start times but punching start not SI Air enabled (not contactless))

Start 700m and up to 15m climb. Allow 15mins

From Heaton Lane car Park and /or Redrock Car park there is no need to visit Assembly

At George Hotel go to East side of main road travel northwards across motorway.

The route will be taped.

There will be a 4 minute call up when you will clear and check before entering the start lanes and then

can collect loose control descriptions, if you require and view a blank map of the area.

Controls are SI AIR enabled (contactless) including Finish.

Finish in assembly.

Course closing time 14:00

Entries Racesignup where you select the class and you will be asked to select your own start time.

Please note if you are running an Open class you will not be eligible for UKUL points.

Entries close 10th October 2025

EOD Limited entry on the Day whilst maps available.
