Terrain Description

Flat Nature Reserve around a lake. Many paths, As it is winter, the Light Green vegetation may not be as severe as the map suggests in many places. Marshes tend to be larger than mapped due to a wet winter and water courses mainly uncrossable See safety notes.

Beware of Rabbit holes.

Facilities

Registration is in a gazebo outside the main buildings. Lit inside toilets will be available which are suitable to change in.

Safety

Marshes/water marked as uncrossable should not be crossed.

The linear water course along the southern part of the map should only be crossed at marked bridges or at path crossing points with care.

Elsewhere it is likely to be too wide and deep.

This is a night event in Winter and the weather may be changeable. Therefore, you may be required to carry or wear a hooded waterproof jacket

A backup lamp and whistle are compulsory

Carrying a mobile phone is strongly recommended.
