

## **Twin Peak 2014 - Additional Entry Information**

### ***Please note the following information regarding entries on Fabian4:***

You can enter any class you choose on both days, but to be eligible for awards in the two competitions, you must run "in class" or "up" on the same course each day.

### **Twin Peak awards.**

Prizes for the leading runner in every age class. Times for the Day 1 Sprint Qualifier, Day 1 Sprint Final and the Day 2 Urban will be added together.

Please note that for Day 1 BOF Ranking points the Qualifier+Final times will be used.

### **NW Sprint Championships.**

The Saturday event is open to all, but awards will be given to the top NW runner in each class. e.g. on course 3 medals will be awarded to the best M55, M60, W40, W45, W50.

### **Juniors.**

Saturday. There are no restrictions on which course juniors can run as there is no traffic in either area.

Sunday. An M/W16 can run any course they choose IF they are 16 on the day of the competition. Any M/W16 who is under 16 on the day must enter Course 6, or be accompanied by an adult (in which case they would not be eligible for awards)

### **Different course each day?**

If you want to run different courses, e.g. an M40 would like to run in Mopen (course 1) on Saturday and M40+ (course 2) on Sunday, you have declare yourself on Fabian4 as 2 different people. This means that you duplicate your "profile", and complete 2 lines of entry details.

Entrants splitting their entry in this manner can claim the £2 all days discount from enquiries on the day.
