



# MDOC member grants policy

Policy applies from 9<sup>th</sup> March 2026

## Scope

This policy covers the provision of financial Grant assistance to members of MDOC who are attending:

1. British Orienteering or NWOA recognised training camps, courses or tours, as a participant, coach or assistant (e.g. logistical support, safeguarding, first aider),
2. British Orienteering recognised regional, national, or international competitions where the member is a competing representative
3. Representing the Club, NWOA, British Orienteering or IOF at official meetings, conferences or exhibitions

## Level of Support

- **Juniors / full-time students:** 50% of personal costs
- **Seniors:** award of grants and the level thereof will be at the discretion of Committee

## Additional Support

Where a member demonstrates exceptional performance or dedication to the sport, and has made a personal financial contribution, the club may provide additional discretionary assistance.

## Application Process

Members should apply in writing to the MDOC Treasurer, providing details of the costs incurred or anticipated, details of any other funding raised or awards received.

All applications for Grant funding will be submitted to the Committee for consideration and final approval.
