

Twin Peak 2017 General notes

Twin Peak Competition

There will be a small prize for the leading member of each age group M/W10 – M/W85 adding together the times for Torver and Bleathwaite events. Those wishing to be eligible for a prize should enter the appropriate course shown on the table for each individual day, or run-up on both days.

Course/Class allocation

Please note that the classes allocated to the various colour courses are, in many cases, different on the 2 days, e.g. M35 run Black on Saturday and Brown on Sunday. You will need to note your course for each day before doing an on-line entry, if you want to be competitive in the 2-day Twin Peak Competition.

Cancellations

90% refunds (minus Fabian charges) will be given for any cancellations received by February 4th. With a limit on numbers on Saturday, your cancellation would allow someone else to take part.

Safety and Risk

A comprehensive risk assessment will have been carried out by the organiser, but participants take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety during the event
