Day One of MDOC Urban Weekend 2022

Event Centre Location: Tytherington School, Manchester Road, Tytherington, Macclesfield. SK10 2EE

Travel: Tytherington School is on the A538 Manchester Road, approximately 750m North of the junction with the A537 in Macclesfield. Signs will only be posted at the entrance to event centre parking.

Parking: Parking will be on hardstanding at the event centre. Please follow marshals' instructions, respect parents dropping off and collecting children at the entrance, and leave disabled spaces clear for a disabled group using the school on the day.

Event Centre: Tytherington School are providing parking, a room for registration and download and toilets adjacent to the assembly room. MDOC do not have sole use of the event centre on the day, so please respect other users.

Facilities: Toilets are available in the event centre. Catering is not being provided- Macclesfield Town Centre is approximately 1,500m South.

Start and Finish Location

The start and finish are 600m (10 minutes) from the event centre with a 20m climb. On the route to the start/finish, runners must cross the main A538 at the manned crossing point.

Terrain



Tytherington is a very pleasant residential area to the north of Macclesfield. It comprises several small developments and the inclusion of paths and uncrossable fences make for interesting route choice.

All courses start in Riverside Park and have a few controls within the park. This is bisected by several paths and runners should not try to navigate through the mapped banks of brambles which are exceedingly fierce.

Riverside Park rises by 25m from bottom to top and the urban area is undulating with no significant hills.

Map and Control Descriptions

The map scale is 1:4000 with 2.5m contours drawn to ISSprOM 2019-2 and includes a new area to the north as far as Tytherington Golf Club. All maps will be A3 in size.

ISSprOM 2019-2 introduces many changes; the only obvious one on this map this a new colour, Dark Green - Impassable (Illegal to cross) Vegetation


Non-standard features: Within Riverside Park an **X** indicates a park bench.

Control descriptions are printed on maps. Loose control descriptions will be available at the start.

Course 7 has written descriptions; all others are pictorial.

Important

There is not enough room for a key on the map so competitors must be familiar with symbols indicating forbidden passage.



Safety and Risks

A comprehensive risk assessment has been completed by the organiser, but participants take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety during the event.

Tytherington is a relatively quiet residential area. Please respect local residents. Adult courses cross a moderately busy residential road- please take care crossing roads.

Riverside Park is a popular park which is likely to be busy with walkers and their dogs on a spring Saturday. Please take care- particularly on blind corners- and respect other park users.

Clothing and Footwear

The majority of each course is on surfaced roads and paths with some parkland. Trainers or rubber-soled O shoes should be fine, no metal studs please.

Shorts are allowed but not recommended. All courses have parkland controls where brambles and undergrowth are likely to be encountered.
