Twin Peak 2009 in the Lake District

Two Regional Events on Place Fell and Angle Tarn Pikes, beside Ullswater

Venue Saturday: Place Fell. White and Yellow courses will use the Silver Point low-level area beside

Ullswater.

Sunday: Angle Tarn Pikes for all courses

Parking and Assembly

Parking will be at Side Farm, Patterdale GR NY 398 162, about 12 miles north of Windermere and 12 miles from junction 40 of the M6 at Penrith. Assembly adjacent to the parking area with all facilities available, including the Side Farm tea-room and campsite. For large vehicles- contact organiser

Dogs On leads in Car Park/Assembly only.

Terrain Place Fell and Angle Tarn Pikes offer fast running on high open fell with large areas of intricate rocky

terrain. There is very little bracken.

There is a long walk to the main start/finish area each day. On Saturday the route is about 2.2km with 300metres climb, partly up a rough, rocky path. On Sunday the route is about 1.2km with 150metres climb up a good path. Block start times and a punching start will allow you to take your time getting to

the starts, enjoying the superb views over the northern Lake District.

Courses As in the 2009 Regional Event Guidelines we are offering courses for all BOF Age Classes, as listed

below. These are the recommended courses for each age group, but you are welcome to enter the

colour course of your choice.

In particular, Juniors should select the colour course that they are competent to run.

String Course each day.

Entry on Day

EOD for all courses (maps being printed on site, so you don't need to arrive too early)

SIpunching will be used. SI-cards available for hire @ 50p per day. (Lost cards £25.00)

Start times Saturday 12.00 to 15.00 (Registration opens at 11.00 for EOD)

Sunday 10.00 to 13.00 (Registration opens at 9.30 for EOD)

People pre-entering both days will be given one early and one late start time, based on their Saturday

preference.

Split starts can be arranged for pre-entries with open start times for the second runner.

A block-start system will be used.

Fees (per day)

Greens, Seniors £11.00, Juniors and Students £3.50. No late entry as there will be EOD.

Blues, EOD surcharge: £1 for Seniors only.

Browns and (Senior fees are reduced by £2 for National BOF members and NWOA Local BOF

Black members)

White to Light Seniors £7.00 (£2 reduction as above), Juniors and Students £3.50 Green
